Medium: Oil paintings

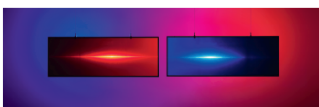
### **Pilvi Ojala**

At the same time the pictures build an illustrated fairy tale, a story of another reality. The duration is approximately ten minutes.

### **Juha Rouhikoski**



Work "horizons" is part of light art work "horizon-series" combining works "red horizon" and "blue horizon". Scale of "horizons" is smaller than the individual works and is presented more of a model of actual full size installations.

Horizons are "light landscapes" acting as views to dreams, views to unknown. Work is a study of colour and depth using minimal amount of eco-friendly LED-lighting technology.

Medium: LED-light fixtures and color filters
